If a class or workshop is cancelled, students will be notified at least 3 business days prior to the first scheduled class or workshop. If you do not hear from CAC, your class will be running as scheduled. CAC reserves the right to make changes in programs, schedules, and instructors, and to cancel classes due to low enrollment. CAC does not prorate classes except for private music classes. CAC reserves the right to cancel or refuse the registration of a student in a class or workshop with no refund, if participation by the student is deemed disruptive or interferes with the learning atmosphere and enjoyment of the class/workshop.

Refund Policy

A \$10 non-refundable processing fee is included in each class tuition. 100% of tuition (less the processing fee) will be refunded if requested at least 1 week prior to the class/workshop; 50% of tuition (less the processing fee) will be refunded if requested after the first class; no refunds will be made if requested after the second class.
